ASYC Guidance for Sailors (Loch of Skene)

Pre- arrival	If sailing is cancelled due to weather, there will be a post on the ASYC Facebook page
On Arrival	 Briefing: there will be a briefing at 1.15pm/ 6.15pm SIGN ON IS IMPORTANT FOR SAFETY: If racing sign on from the top of the sign-on sheet; Note down whether you'll be in the first start (experienced) or second start (novices) If cruising sign on from the bottom of the sign on sheet. Sign-on sheet is on club room table if you arrive late sign on by visiting the OOD or Rescue RIB as soon as possible after you launch, or radio OOD from a radio in the clubroom
On the water	 You can only sail when there is a RIB out on the water. That's a condition of ASYC's use of the Loch. Racing: start sequence is 3-2-1-0. There will be two starts, the second is for novices. Both starts will be combined for the race results. Cruising: please try not to obstruct or interfere with a boat that's racing
After sailing	 Stop for tea, coffee and chat and if you raced, check the results to see how you did
