

# ASYC Guidance for Sailors (Loch of Skene)

<b>Pre-arrival</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If sailing is cancelled due to weather, there will be a post on the ASYC Facebook page</li></ul>
<b>On Arrival</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Briefing:</b> there will be a briefing at 1.15pm/ 6.15pm</li><li>• <b><u>SIGN ON IS IMPORTANT FOR SAFETY:</u></b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ <b>If racing</b> sign on from the top of the sign-on sheet;<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Note down whether you'll be in the first start (experienced) or second start (novices)</li></ul></li><li>○ <b>If cruising</b> sign on from the bottom of the sign on sheet.</li><li>○ <b>Sign-on sheet</b> is on club room table</li><li>○ <b>if you arrive late</b> sign on by visiting the OOD or Rescue RIB as soon as possible after you launch, or radio OOD from a radio in the clubroom</li></ul></li></ul>
<b>On the water</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>You can only sail</b> when there is a RIB out on the water. That's a condition of ASYC's use of the Loch.</li><li>• <b>Racing:</b> start sequence is 3-2-1-0. There will be two starts, the second is for novices. Both starts will be combined for the race results.</li><li>• <b>Cruising:</b> please try not to obstruct or interfere with a boat that's racing</li></ul>
<b>After sailing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Stop for tea, coffee and chat</b></li><li>• .. and if you raced, check the results to see how you did</li></ul>
